



Introduction

Pennington Parish Council (the “Council”) is committed to ensuring that its website (<https://pennington-pc.gov.uk>) (the “Website”) is accessible to everyone, including people with disabilities. This statement explains how we are meeting this commitment.

Compliance status

This Website aims to meet the requirements of:

- Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) Accessibility Regulations 2018
- Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 AA standards
- Freedom of Information Act 2000 (required publications)
- Transparency Code for Smaller Authorities

What we are doing to improve accessibility

We regularly review the Website to improve accessibility and ensure compliance. Our actions include, but are not limited to:

- Conducting an accessibility audit and remedying issues found
- Ensuring any new content, pages or features follow accessibility best-practice
- Providing text alternatives for non-text content (images, icons) where feasible
- Ensuring proper headings structure, keyboard navigation, colour contrast, resizing of text, and appropriate ARIA roles where needed
- Publishing documents (PDFs, Word files) in accessible formats, or providing a plain-text or HTML alternative where possible
- Monitoring third-party content (such as embedded maps, videos or links) to maintain accessibility
- Allocating responsibility for accessibility within the Council’s digital governance arrangements

Non-compliance issues	Some older PDF/Word documents may not fully meet accessibility standards (e.g., scanned images, lack of tagging). We endeavour to gradually convert/replace these wherever possible. Some third-party embedded content (e.g., maps, external documents) may not fully comply
Feedback loop	We use user feedback, periodic audits, and monitoring of accessibility tools to identify issues and plan improvements

Domain and email-governance context

In accordance with the requirements of Assertion 10 – Digital and Data Compliance for smaller authorities, the Council is using an email address and domain under its control rather than a free-service personal email. The Website is hosted and maintained under the Council's governance arrangements to ensure compliance, security and continuity.

Data protection and other relevant legal duties

As part of the Council's governance responsibilities under the Data Protection Act 2018 and the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the Council ensures the Website's digital operations (including email, website publishing and data management) follow proper practices, secure handling of personal data, and reflect the Council's adopted IT and data policies.
